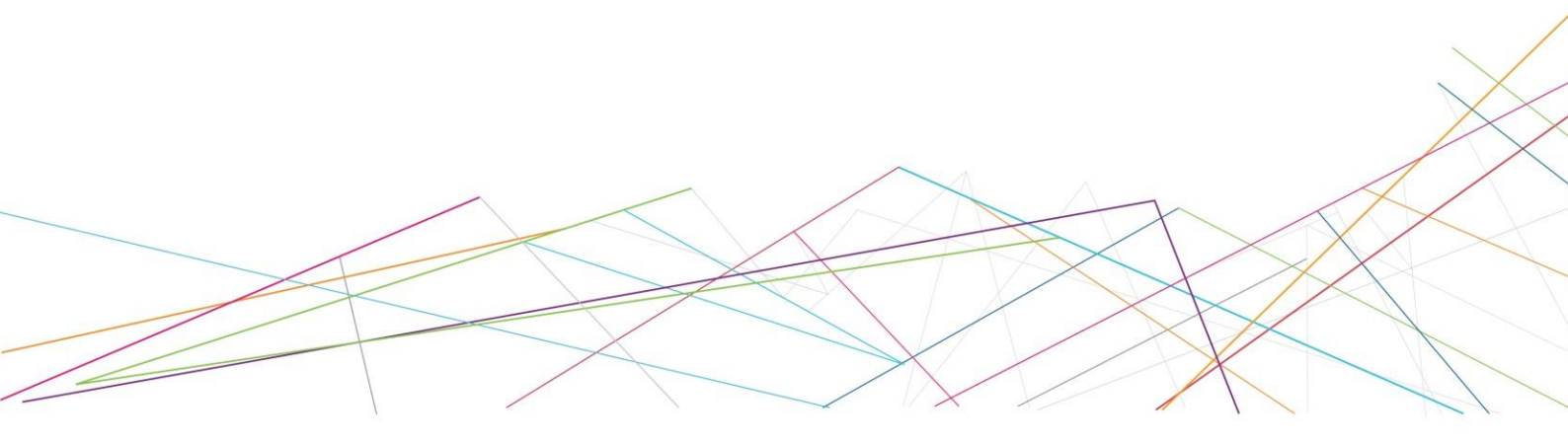

London AHSN and AHSC response to *Better Health for London*, report of the London Health Commission

Wednesday 15 October 2014

Today the London Health Commission published its report, *Better Health for London*, and presented ten aspirations for improving health and care in the capital to the Mayor of London, Boris Johnson.
